

# USEFUL INFORMATION FOR HACKNEY PASSENGERS

#### YOU ARE ENTITLED TO:

- > agree the fare in advance;
- a clean vehicle and quiet journey; and
- a receipt on payment of fare.



## YOU ARE OBLIGED TO:

- **>** pay the fare agreed;
- behave in a civil and orderly fashion; and
- > not damage the vehicle or its contents.

### RECOGNISING A LICENCED DRIVER

The Driver ID Card is displayed on the dashboard. It specifies:

- > the driver's name;
- > the driver's licence number; and
- > the driver's licence expiry date

Purple and yellow Driver ID Cards are in operation.





#### RECOGNISING A LICENCED VEHICLE

A Tamper Proof Licence Disc is displayed on the front and rear windows. It specifies:



- the vehicle licence number;
- the vehicle registration number;
- the number of passengers the vehicle is licensed to carry; and
- **>** the vehicle licence expiry date.

## RECOVERING LOST PROPERTY

- If you booked your hackney through a dispatch operator, contact them first.
- An Garda Síochána is responsible for lost property handed in by hackney operators.
- > Provide the Gardaí with the licence number of the hackney (shown on your receipt) together with a full description of the lost property.
- > The Gardaí will ask for proof of identity before handing over property.
